Summer Program Choices Are..

Parent & Me (ages 20 to 30 months) meets 2x week

This class is designed to give you, the parent and your child, the opportunity to have fun at camp. Songs, art activities, music, snacks and playground time is all a part of the program. Get messy and play with your young one.

ALEF Young 3s (ages 2.10 months to 3.10 mo)

Are you ready for your child to play with paint, watercolors, learn new songs, play in the playground, have snack and get wet? This is the place for you. Our program is designed with a Senior Counselor, Jr. Counselor and CIT as helpers. Your child does not need to be Potty trained. We ask that you supply the necessary changes for your week (s) at camp. A great place to get them used to attending their future preschool. No offsite trips.

BET - 4 year olds

If your child is 4 years of age they can attend any day of the week. These children will do art, sports, gardening, water play, games, ride bikes, get messy and have a great time. Hours 9 to 2 pm
Judaica and Shabbat will be part of their program as well. No offsite trips.

GIMMEL 5 & 6 years old

If your child is between the ages of 6-8 they can attend any day of the week from 9 to 2 pm each day. There will be activities, programming, drama, art, music making and more.

DALED 7 to 9 years old

If your child is between the ages of 7-9 they can attend any day of the week from 9 to 2 pm each day. There will be activities, programming, drama, art, music making and more.





Camp Haverim Staff

Our staff members are hired for their enthusiasm, creativity and ability to provide a nurturing, caring and fun atmosphere. We provide thorough training including child development, varied activities, daily planning, along with emergency procedures, water safety, CPR and First Aid.

We have qualified senior staff made up of experienced and informed adults who are college age and older. Our junior counselors are 11th and 12th grade high school students who support the senior staff members throughout the day. Our CIT's are guided and mentored for future Jr. Counselor roles.
