- **All recipients enjoy** canned fruits, soups & vegetables, chicken and tuna, pasta and sauce and breakfast bars. **Kids love mac & cheese and peanut butter.**

MONETARY DONATIONS: Those who prefer to donate money may give cash or check made out to FOOD Share Inc. \$1 creates almost 3 individual meals. A collection jar will be in the PODS Container or envelopes may be placed in the Temple Office mailbox in the hall. They will be forwarded as a group.
