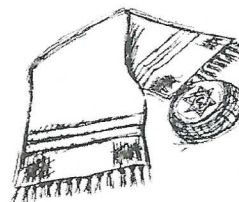
5:00 p.m. Tashlich Gathering: Brief readings and singing. Join us in symbolically casting our sins into the water.

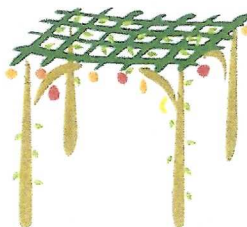
